CONVOCATION FOR THE BRITISH EDUCATIONAL MISSION

A University Convocation in honor of the visiting British Educational Mission will be held at the University Armory at 10:25 a.m. on Friday, November 15th.

Members of the Mission, guests from other institutions, regents, deans, and faculties will march in academic costume from the Library to the Armory, following the route adopted for commencement processions. The members of the Mission, regents, deans, and guests from other institutions will be seated on the platform. Other members of the faculty will be seated in the center section of the Armory. The remainder of the ground floor of the Armory will be assigned to one regiment of the S. A. T. C. Because of the limited capacity of the Armory, the general public will not be admitted.

Only members of the collegiate sections of the student body can be accommodated. Civilian students will be admitted to the balcony upon presentation of their passes. S. A. T. C. students will enter in military formation.

Tickets for wives of members of the faculty may be secured upon request at the Registrar's office. Wives of members of the Board of Regents and of visiting guests may secure similar accommodation. All members of the faculty who propose to attend this Convocation should notify the Registrar's office to that effect not later than Thursday evening, November 14 (today).

The attention of all instructors is called to the special boxes which have been put up in each building for "Absence Reports." Both S. A. T.
