KROX Radio to Host UMC Basketball Show Starting Wednesday at 5:30 p.m. from Crookston Inn



CROOKSTON, Minn. – KROX Radio will debut their weekly UMC Basketball Show live from the Crookston Inn Wednesday nights from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m. The first show will be on 1260 KROX AM/105.7 FM on Wed., Dec. 2. The show will be hosted by KROX Radio personality Matt Bishop, who is in his second season calling UMC athletics for Crookston radio staple KROX Radio.

The first 30 minutes of the show will be focused on the women's basketball program with interviews with Head Coach [Mike Roysland](#) and players, while the last 30 minutes will center on the men's basketball program with interviews with Head Coach [Dan Weisse](#) and players.

The Crookston Inn will provide food for the coaches, while also providing a great host spot for the radio program.

Roysland is in his 10th season with the Golden Eagles and have UMC off to a 4-1 start (1-0 NSIC) after going to the NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament and hosting a home playoff game. The Golden Eagles are highlighted by seniors [Alexa Thielman](#) (G, Buffalo, Minn./Health Science) and [Katrina Nordick](#) (F, Perham, Minn./Applied Studies). Both players were All-NSIC First Team selections as juniors, while Nordick was named NSIC North Preseason Player of the Year for the 2015-16 season.

Weisse is in his second season with the Golden Eagles. UMC is currently 2-3 (0-1 NSIC) as they continue to build the program. The Golden Eagles are young with 12 players who are in their first years playing collegiate basketball. UMC has been led by their lone senior and returning leading scorer [Derrick Redd, Jr.](#) (G, Menifee, Calif./Sports and Rec Management), who is off to a strong start to his senior season.

KROX Radio has been a staple in the Crookston community since 1948 and has been vital in covering UMC athletic events over the years. The station is currently owned and operated by Chris Fee, recently gaining an FM signal this year on 105.7 FM, as well as 1260 AM.

The Crookston Inn and Convention Center is located just south of the UMC campus on U.S. Highway 2. It is the only full-service hotel in Crookston. The Crookston Inn has 72 sleeping rooms, a full-size swimming pool, restaurant, and bar. They offer pool side rooms; wireless internet services is available throughout the hotel.
