DULUTH -- Edwin O. Siggelkow, coordinator of student activities and Kirby Student Center at the University of Minnesota, Duluth (UMD) today, was named director of Coffman Memorial Union on the University's Minneapolis campus.

The announcement was made by Donald R. Zander, director of University Unions at Minneapolis.

Siggelkow, who took over management of Kirby Student Center in 1956, will assume his new position in Minneapolis on July 1. He will replace Gordon L. Starr who has become planning director for University Unions, Zander said.

Siggelkow presently administers student activities including the UMD Kirby Student Center building and program. He is advisor to the UMD Student Association and secretary of faculty-student committees on student affairs, Kirby Student Center policy and convocations.

He also is a member of the campus safety and civil defense, the University calendar and the parking and transportation committees. He received student government faculty-staff awards in 1957 and 1958.

A native of Burlington, Wis. Siggelkow graduated from Washington High School in Milwaukee and received the Bachelor of Philosophy degree in psychology and an M.S. degree in guidance and student personnel work from the University of Wisconsin. He also worked on his Ph.D. degree while at the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis.

Siggelkow joined the Minneapolis staff in 1950 after holding a personnel position at Wisconsin. During his five years at Minneapolis, before coming to UMD, he was financial advisor to student organizations and advisor to academic fraternities and social action groups and received an outstanding service award from the Inter-fraternity Council.
