DULUTH--The University Chorus and the Concert Choir will be featured in UMD's spring choral concert at 8:15 p.m. Tuesday(May 28) in Kirby Student Center ballroom.

Both groups will be directed by Allen Downs, assistant professor of music.

Concert Choir selections will include works from 17th century composers G. Gabrieli, Monteverdi and Schein to the more recent literature of Charles Ives, McKay and Niles.

The University Chorus will present an Arensky "Serenade" scored with 'cello obligato, performed by Patricia A. Maher, Two Harbors; Bach's "Now Let Every Tongue Adore Thee" conducted by Mary Wright, senior from Fergus Falls; and Jacob's "Ash Grove" conducted by James Cole, Duluth senior. The program also will include works by Arcadelt, Lockwood and Cain.
