Duluth -- The UMD Library passed the 100,000 volume mark during fiscal 1965-66 and received over \$5,000 from the federal government for further acquisitions during 1966-67.

The information is contained in the annual report prepared and released by Rudolph Johnson, assistant professor and head librarian.

"We are proud to have passed the 100,000 mark and have come of age as a medium-sized college library. We rank tenth among Minnesota colleges in the size of our book collection," said Johnson.

Federal funds were provided for additional volumes through Title II of the Higher Education Act of 1965.

"We received \$311.52 for the Laboratory School Library and \$5,000 for general Library," said Johnson.

The \$5,000 was matched with \$10,800 in the library's end-of-year funds, added Johnson.
