Duluth--- The appointment of 35 civic leaders in 22 Northern Minnesota, Wisconsin and Michigan cities to promote the sale of University Artists Series season tickets was announced today.

Mrs. Perry Gallagher, Duluth, Series Out-Of-Town Committee chairman, said the chairmen will organize mail and telephone sales efforts in their respective areas.

Metropolitan Opera tenor Jan Peerce will appear at the Duluth Auditorium November 19th, the first concert star in the University Artists Series sponsored by UMD.

Other artists this year will be Flamenco guitarist Carlos Montoya on Jan. 7, French pianist Philippe Entremont on Feb. 11, and television star John Gary on April 15.

Mrs. Gallagher said season ticket application forms are available now from the 35 area chairmen.

Regular season tickets at \$10.50, \$13.50 and \$16.50 are on sale in Duluth at the Glass Block, Goldfines, the Duluth Auditorium, and 101 Kirby Student Center at UMD. Season tickets may be charged to accounts at Glass Block and Goldfines.

Discount season tickets for students, faculty and staff of UMD, the College of St. Scholastica and Wisconsin State University at Superior are available now at the three campuses for \$8.00, \$11.00 and \$14.00. There will be no discount price for single-concert tickets.

Mrs. Gallagher said checks for season tickets purchased in person or by mail should be made out to the University of Minnesota, Duluth. Seats will be assigned according to the date received, and charter season ticket holders will have renewal privileges for the 1969-70 concert season.
