



Minnesota Crookston Hockey Ranked 18th in Latest ACHA Division II Central Region Poll

TROY, Mich. – The University of Minnesota Crookston hockey team was ranked in the most recent ACHA Division II Central Region rankings. The Golden Eagles were ranked 18th in the Central Region. The ranking marks the first for UMN Crookston this season. The Golden Eagles were ranked nationally during the 2020-21 season, finishing the year ranked No. 20.

The Golden Eagles come into the weekend with a 5-5-2 (2-2-2 WCCHA) mark. UMN Crookston has a victory over regionally ranked University of Minnesota, a tie with regionally ranked Minnesota State University, and a win over Dakota College at Bottineau, ranked in the West Region.
