Feedback on Policies:

- [Academic Integrity Subcommittee Charge/Membership](#): recommend consulting Academic Advising Committee and possible addition of an academic advisor to the membership
- [Course Enrollment Limits & Cancellation \(#2\)](#): Concern with cancelling a class up until the 2nd class meeting of the term as this could negatively impact a student. Establishing this as a practice is disadvantageous to the student. Discussion: impact the students ability to receive financial aid if unable to replace class with an alternative class, could impact a students ability to make adequate progress towards graduation if a class is cancelled that needed to graduate in final term, etc. Would prefer to keep the vetoed language: *“Course cancellations must occur before the first day of the term to allow students greater opportunity to enroll in other course options.”*
- [Exams outside of Regular Class Time Policy](#): Supports change in verbiage and to support the best test opportunities for students. Students who are working multiple jobs and have a take home extended period exam will be setup for failure. Ensuring the policy is aligned to student success.
