James Rothenberger is a native of Minneapolis and completed both his undergraduate and graduate studies at the University of Minnesota. He joined the faculty of the School of Public Health in 1972 and is also an adjunct faculty member of the University of St. Thomas.

Jim has primary responsibility for undergraduate courses in Public Health and serves as a faculty advisor for undergraduates in University College. He also teaches courses on AIDS and Health Education. He has been a team teacher with Professor Mathews for the course, *Dying and Death in Contemporary Society*, jointly offered by the Program of Mortuary Science and the School of Public Health.

Jim has served on numerous state and national advisory committees, ranging from chairing the AIDS Advisory Committee for the Minnesota Department of Education to a national task force on Human Papilloma Virus (Genital Warts). For the last six years, he has headed a federal training grant in Minnesota which trains health professionals in AIDS clinical care. In his spare time, he has coffee once a month with the past and current funeral directors in Grand Marais, Minnesota.
