☞ Minnesota has equal or fewer penalties than its opponent in 10 of 14 games, including seven of nine home contests, this season

☞ After having forwards score 70 straight goals dating back to the end of last season, the Golden Gophers have now received five goals from defensemen in their last four games (Leopold-3, Mills-2)

☞ Minnesota has outshot its opponent 140-91 in the third period of games this season

☞ Minnesota now steps away from WCHA action until a Jan. 9-10, 1999 series at Denver - the next league series at home is Jan. 29-30, 1999 against Michigan Tech

☞ Minnesota has outscored its opponents 8-2 in the first period of wins, but has been outnumbered 16-5 in the first frame of losses and ties

☞ The Golden Gophers have not been shutout in their last 146 games, while blanking their opponents on 14 occasions in that time span

☞ Minnesota had trailed in the third period of its last five games before taking a 4-0 lead into the third period of Saturday's 4-1 win over UAA

☞ This weekend will mark the fourth time in the last eight seasons that Minnesota will follow its trip to Alaska-Anchorage with a nonconference opponent - Minnesota is 7-7-0 in two-game sets the last seven seasons following its trips to UAA

☞ Minnesota ranks fourth in the WCHA on the power-play and fifth in the league in penalty-kill percentage

☞ The Golden Gophers are 3-14-1 in their last 18 games in the month of November

☞ Despite an 0-for-6 mark on the power play last weekend, Minnesota is still an efficient 7-for-26 (.269) with the man advantage on the road - the Golden Gophers are 7-for-53 (.132) on the power play at Mariucci Arena
