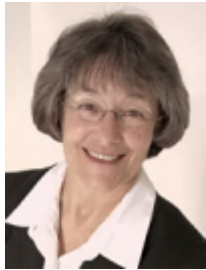

# Summer 2006: Candidate Policy Forum with Becky Lourey (DFL)

As part of its 2006 Elections Project, the Center for the Study of Politics and Governance hosted a series of policy talks featuring candidates for statewide elective office. Lourey's professional experience includes work as a family farmer, artist, and health care advocate. She and her husband co-own and manage a software company based in north-central Minnesota.
