Duluth--- Thirteen programs on linguistics featuring commentary by a UMD faculty member will be run from 7:05 to 8 p.m. Thursdays this fall on UMD's campus FM radio station, KUMD.

Entitled 'New Aspects of Language,' the programs will consist of a taped half-hour panel discussion and a 25-minute commentary by Donald Larmouth, UMD instructor of English.

The tapes were prepared at George Peabody College for Teachers in Nashville and released through the National Educational Radio Network. They are designed to acquaint laymen with developments in the field of linguistics and language study.

Larmouth will comment on the panel discussions to clarify points and to present his own opinions on the panel discussions. He also will have other UMD faculty members as guests on the programs.
