CROOKSTON, Minn. – The University of Minnesota Crookston equestrian team announced the addition of Adrienne Schaunaman (Aberdeen, S.D./Colby Community College). Schaunaman will compete for the Western Equestrian team for the Golden Eagles.

"Adrienne joins the Golden Eagle Equestrian family with a wealth of experience," said Head Coach *Kayla Hanson*. "Transferring from Colby Community College, she successfully competed on their IHSA Western squad representing in both the Open Reining and Open Horsemanship. Adrienne is a fierce competitor that radiates both skill and confidence in and out of the arena. I look forward to having her join our talented group of Open Horsemanship and Reining riders as we advance into the NCEA."

Schaunaman has already competed at a high level in Open Horsemanship and Open Reining, competing in the IHSA for Colby Community College in Colby, Kan. She also helps the Golden Eagles replace graduated open riders *Whitney Eganza* (Foley, Minn.) and *Madeline Provost* (Milaca, Minn.).

She joins a Golden Eagle western squad that competed at a high level in the IHSA in 2019-20, sending four riders on to the IHSA Semi-Finals in Bethany, Okla., prior to the cancellation of the season due to Covid-19. Minnesota Crookston had strong showings in the region. The Golden Eagles will also compete in the NCEA in 2020-21. Minnesota Crookston took part in an NCEA exhibition at South Dakota State University in Brookings, S.D., during the 2019-20 season.

The student-athlete listed as having signed a National Letter of Intent or Offer of Admission to compete in equestrian at the University of Minnesota Crookston have been verified by the Minnesota Crookston compliance office once they sign the National Letter of Intent or once the student-athlete has accepted an Offer of Admission for Minnesota Crookston.

Schaunaman was a Level II Regional Champion during the 2019-20. She was a Novice Regional Champion during the 2017-18 season. Schaunaman has made it to the IHSA Semi-Finals. She competed at Colby Community College in Kansas for two seasons. Schaunaman was Jr. Miss Rodeo South Dakota. She is originally from Aberdeen, S.D.

She is the daughter of Chad and Mysty Schaunaman. Schaunaman was born Sept. 8, 1998. She plans to major in equine science at Minnesota Crookston.
