REMINDER--FACULTY MEETING-----The UMD faculty will meet in Room 70 Home Economics Building Friday, December 11, at 2:30 p.m. Items for the agenda include: (1) Library building plans, and (2) University admission policies, 1965-66.

INTER-CAMPUS BUS-----The inter-campus bus service will terminate Thursday, December 10. The dinner-hour bus for dormitory residents will run through December 18. (R. W. Bridges)

CHRISTMAS TEA-----The annual Christmas Tea for the entire UMD staff, academic and civil service, will be held from 4 to 7 p.m. Saturday, December 12, at the Provost's residence, 2531 East Seventh Street.

CHANGES IN RESERVED PARKING-----An additional row of reserved parking (third row) in Science Parking Lot A has been made reserved for those holding a reserved parking permit. All reserved parking in the lower Science Lot B has been discontinued effective December 9, 1964. This change is a result of action by the Parking and Transportation Committee. (R. W. Bridges)

GRADES-----A reminder that fall quarter grade reports are due in the Office of Admissions and Records, Room 130 Kirby Student Center, within 72 hours after completion of the examination. For example, grades for an examination completed at 6 p.m. Saturday, December 12, must be submitted by 6 p.m. Tuesday, December 15. Grades for the final examination completed at 4 p.m. Friday, December 18, must be submitted by 4 p.m. Monday, December 21. If an 8 a.m. deadline is in effect, it will be extended one-half hour. (H.
