DULUTH --- A half-day institute on "Ball-Handling--An Exploratory Approach" will be held at the UMD Physical Education building from 9 a.m. to noon Saturday (April 11).

The institute is intended as in-service instruction for elementary classroom teachers, physical education teachers, principals, and supervisors in physical education.

The program will cover demonstrations of a developmental sequence for exploring ball-handling through a problem solving technique. Children from Grades 1 and 2 of the UMD Laboratory School will show how they find their own solutions to the problems that the teacher sets for them.

The institute will be directed by Sue Nelson, supervisor of elementary physical education at the Laboratory School. Moderators for the institute are:

Nancy Johnson, a UMD physical education instructor; Eugene Bergman, principal of the Munger and Franklin elementary schools; Mrs. Joan Likely and Robert Higgins, both Laboratory School supervisors.
