CROOKSTON, Minn. – The University of Minnesota Crookston volleyball team announced the signing of Sabrina Leuer (MH, 5-10, Hamel, Minn./Wayzata H.S.) to play for the Golden Eagles beginning in the Fall of 2015. Leuer joins signees Callie Schapekahn (MH, 6-0, Eagan, Minn./Eagan H.S.) and Alex Oaks (S, 5-9, Cloquet, Minn./Cloquet H.S.).

"Sabrina is a strong and physical athlete!" said UMC Head Coach [Lee Anderson](#). "She jumps well and hits the ball hard, Sabrina has a great work ethic and I think she will be an awesome teammate, I am very happy she is a part of the Golden Eagle Volleyball family!"

The Golden Eagles are looking to replace a strong senior class that includes [Brittany Looker](#), one of the best players in school history, along with middle hitter [Morgan VanGerpen](#), one of UMC's all-time blocks leaders, and [Mary Mikutowski](#), the starting libero for most of the season.

Leuer tallied 203 kills as a senior for Wayzata H.S. She hit .306 for the season in 153 sets player. In addition, Leuer had 69 blocks of the season and had 41 service aces. She played for Minnesota Select club team for two years and Vital club team for one year.

Leuer is the daughter of Steve and Jackie Leuer. She was born July 7, 1997. Leuer plans to major in agriculture on UMC. Her father Steve wrestled at MSU Moorhead.

All signees are contingent upon admission to UMC and compliance with NCAA rules, including certification by the NCAA Eligibility Center. Everyone released today has signed their National Letter of Intent prior to release of information.
