[In these minutes: review of policies; Twin Cities undergraduate curriculum committee]

Professor Koch thanked Committee members for attending and said that the purpose of the meeting was to decide how to approach the review of Senate educational policies, an effort that the Committee has been working on for several years. She also reported that the Committee needed to deal with the issue of the Twin Cities Undergraduate Course and Curriculum Committee (TCUCCC), that it should review the proposal from the Council on Liberal Education for liberal education requirements under semesters, and that it should consider its relationship with the ROTC program and committee.

It was agreed that the Committee would not meet any more this summer, but that individual members would work on reviewing, revising, rewriting, and consolidating policies, with the expectation that there would be a "final draft" ready for presentation to the full Committee by September 15. Thereafter, the Committee would identify the policies that require additional consultation with the colleges and the administration. Meantime, over the summer, the individuals working on the policies would be free to consult with whomever they believed appropriate.

It was also agreed:

- That the group being assembled by Dr. Zetterberg should have two representatives from SCEP. Drs. Engstrand and Van Essendelft are to do so.
- For each SCEP group working on policy revisions, one member should have lead responsibility.
- Committee members should discuss, via email, the proposal from the Council on Liberal Education.
- The TCUCCC and ROTC issues can be taken up Fall Quarter.

Professor Koch adjourned the meeting at 11:00.
