DULUTH -- Spring quarter enrollment at the University of Minnesota, Duluth (UMD) set a record of 3,775 undergraduate students, 10% above the total last year, Provost Raymond W. Darland announced today.

Sixty graduate students placed the overall spring enrollment figure at 3,835. The total UMD gain over 1965 was 350 students.

Total enrollment for the entire University was 36,799, eight per cent or 2,737 more students than one year ago, according to R. E. Summers, Dean of Admissions and Records.

The percentage of decline in enrollment from winter to spring quarters was 7%, about 1% less than what has been considered normal, explained Summers.

Summers pointed out that the figures indicate a further decline in the ratio of men to women; 24,376 men and 12,423 women. This possible trend was first noted in the spring of 1965, he said. At that time there were 22,885 men and 11,177 women.
