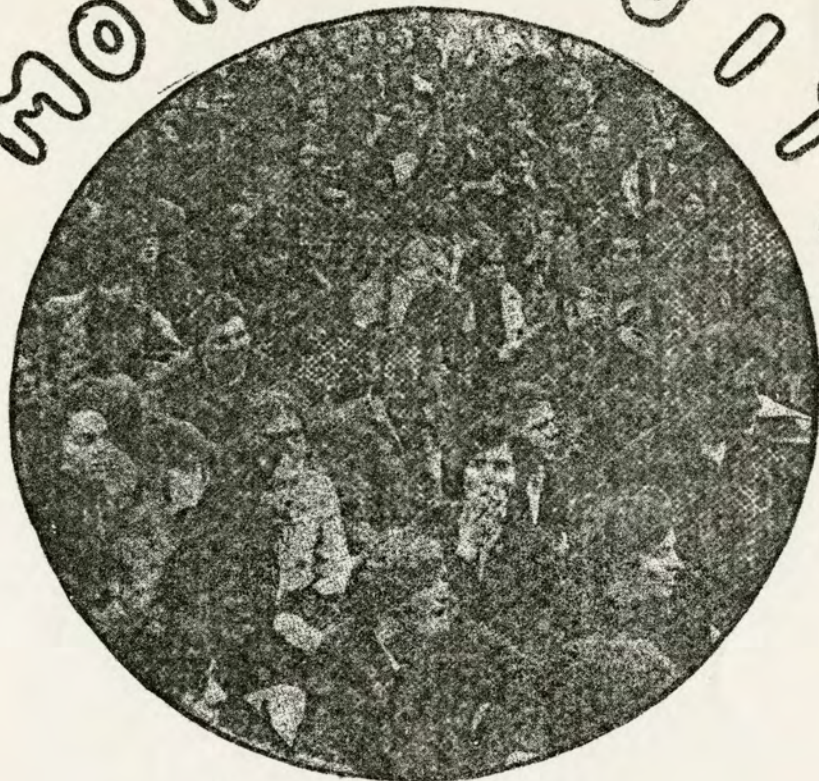

Who would be hurt by a tuition increase? Perhaps the University should look again at the results of their own survey. In response to a questionnaire as how a \$100-200 cost increase would affect them 9.6% said they would be forced to drop out for at least one quarter, 1.2% would drop out entirely and 64% said they would be forced to work more or obtain a job.

Coupling this with another query from the same questionnaire 24.1% said their grades were hurt by working and 49.1% felt they were forced to curtail extra-curricular, educational and cultural activities.
