This includes three power play goals and one unassisted goal.

The Sabres of Marian College have a record of 2-3-0 overall and 2-0-0 in the MCHA after dropping two non-conference games against Bethel University by scores of 7-3 and 4-3 (OT) this past weekend. They are led by **Brendan Hull** who has five goals and three assists for eight points.
