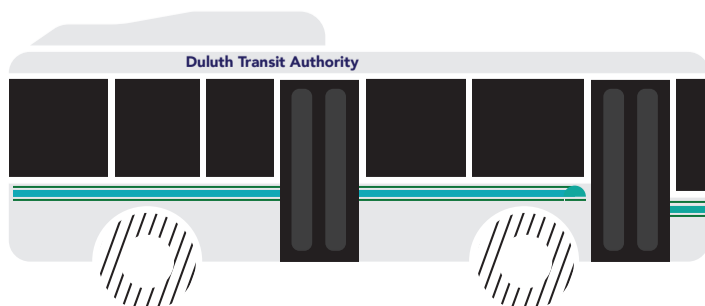

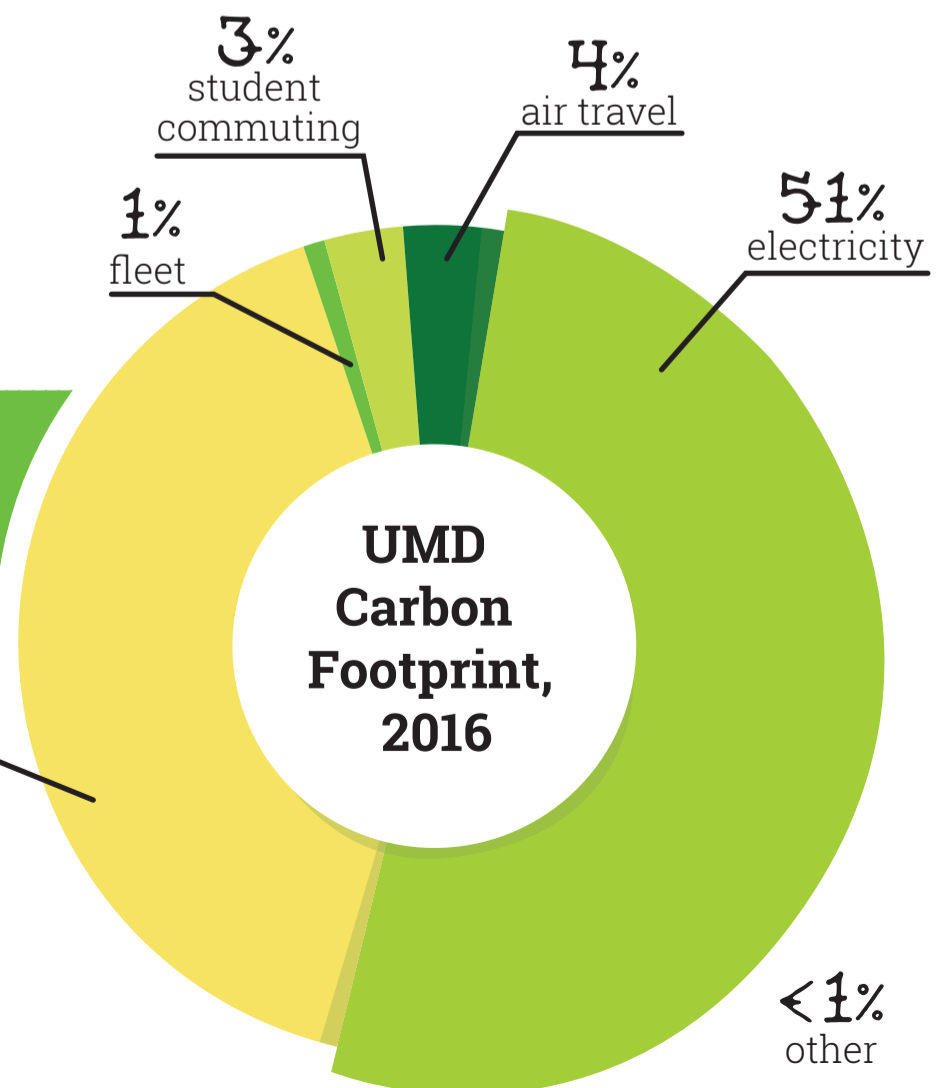


1045 TONS organic waste was diverted from landfills at UMD in 2017
