DULUTH--The Minnesota State Firearms Safety Course for boys and girls between the ages of 12-16 will be conducted from 1-2:30 p.m. Monday and Wednesday each week during the second UMD summer term beginning July 22.

Youngsters can register for the class from 7:45 a.m. -- 4:30 p.m. Monday in the ROTC building adjacent to the Physical Education building. A \$2 registration fee will be charged to cover books and 15 rounds of .22 cal. ammunition.

Group leadership students will serve as instructors under the supervision of Lt. Col. Harold J. Hopkins, professor of air science at UMD.

Those who successfully complete the course, including a written state examination and a practical field trip, will receive a state firearms certificate which may be used in lieu of a small game license.
