DULUTH -- The UMD Department of Physical Education for Women will sponsor Teacher Workshops in Dancing on Saturday (April 22) in the Physical Education building.

Two workshops--one in modern dance and the other in ballroom dance--will be held independently of each other and each limited to 40 participants.

Mrs. Shirley Mordine of Chicago, a former UMD faculty member, will conduct the modern dance workshop from 10 a.m. to noon.

It is designed to give a well-balanced overview of dance techniques, methodology and knowledge for teaching modern dance in the junior or senior high school.

The ballroom dance workshop is scheduled from 1-3 p.m. with instruction by Mrs. Eleanor Burns, a Duluth dance instructor who teaches a UMD course in ballroom dancing twice a week.

Mrs. Burns' workshop is directed at junior or senior high school teachers who wish to incorporate ballroom dance in the curriculum. She will present teaching techniques, including dance terminology and basic steps for the Fox Trot, Waltz, Cha Cha Cha and the Swing.
