100% agreed the retreat promoted deeper understanding/respect for others

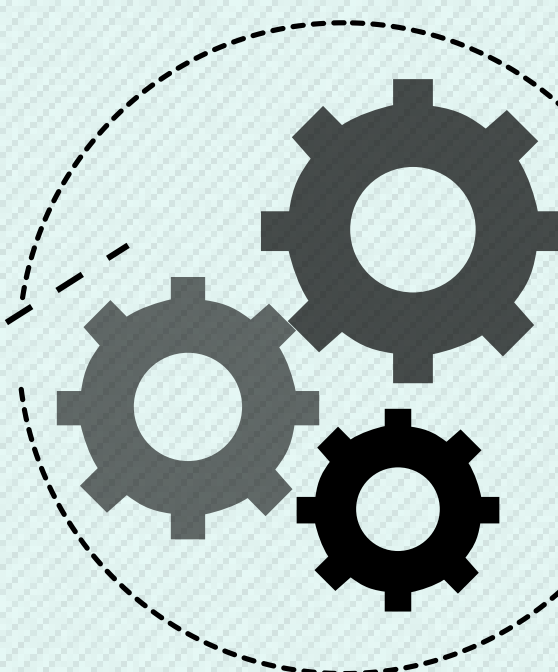
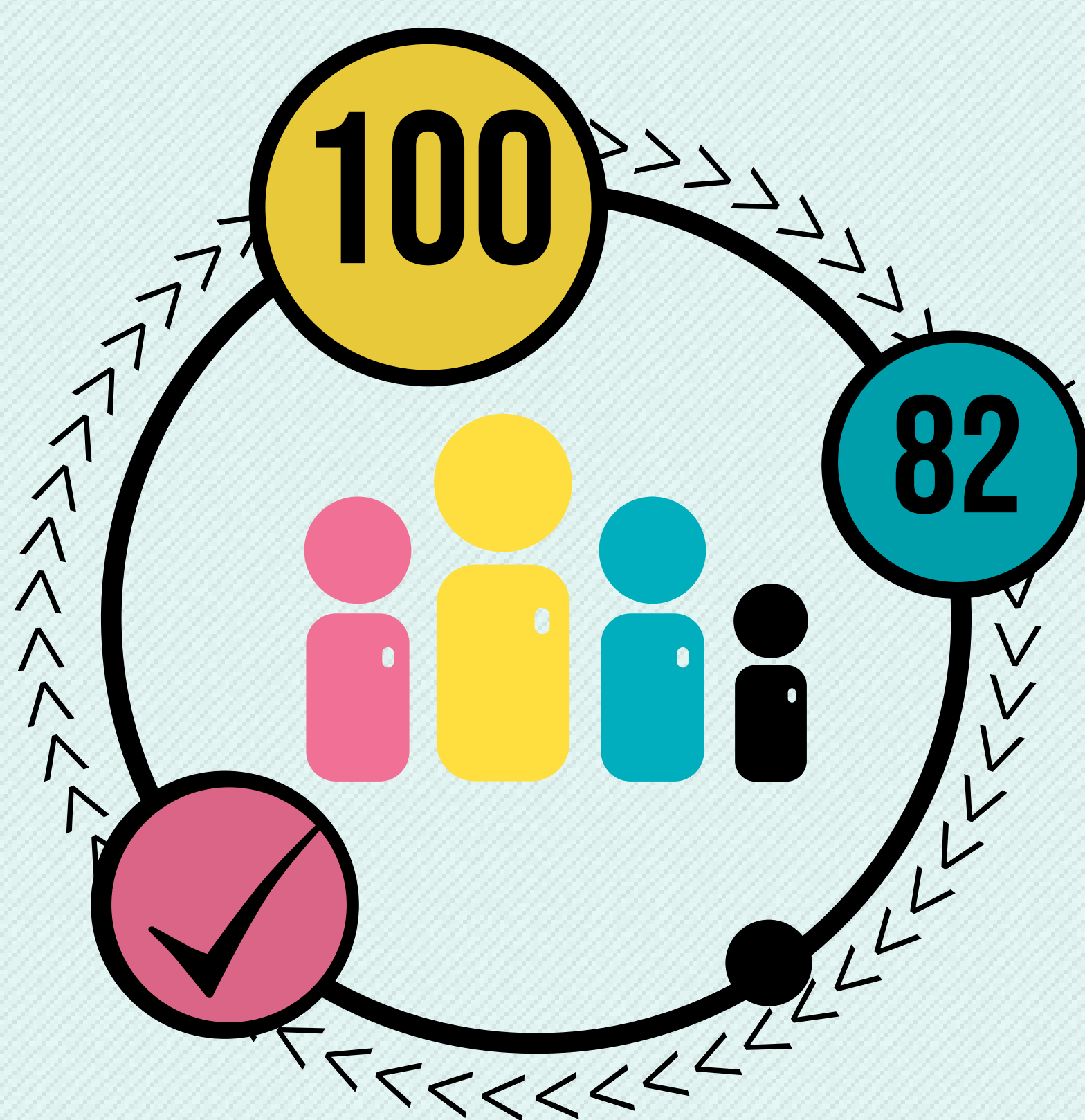
96% agreed the retreat helped them learn about diverse groups

Student Life staff are required to participate in diversity, equity and inclusion training

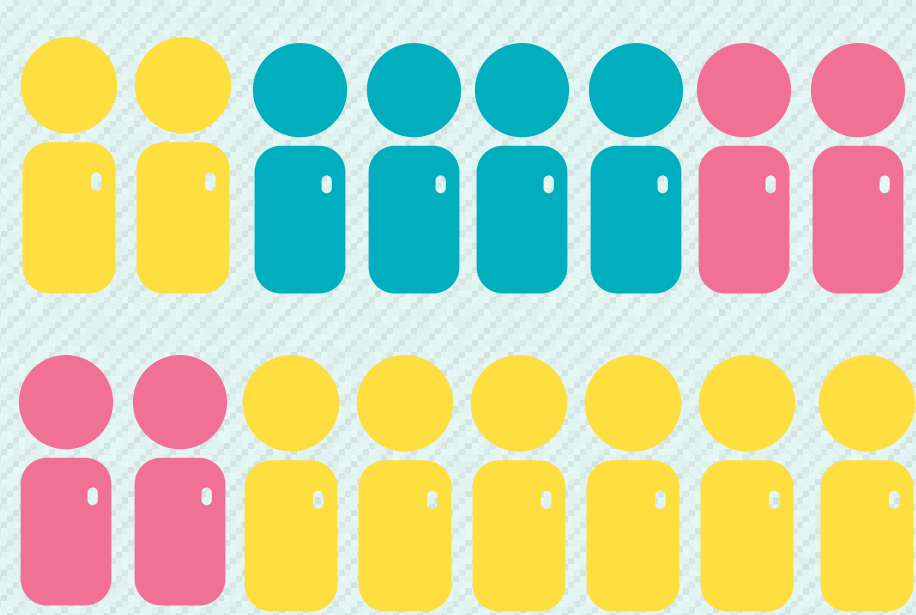
