Why is green grass and nature important to us?

A Heart

What is the heart filled with? Why?

Noses, Mouths, Eyes

How are these things different and the same?

What do you think this exhibit is about?

Think about the clues you discovered on the hunt...

Now look at the picture of the black and white birds...

What do you think the black birds are thinking? Are they friendly or unfriendly? What would happen if the white bird talked to the black birds? What would they say? Would the saying "Birds of a feather flock together" fit this picture? Does this mean that everyone should stay with his/her OWN group?
