DULUTH--The UMD Christmas Concert, featuring the orchestra, chorale and choir, will be presented at 8:15 p.m. Tuesday(Dec.3) in Kirby Student Center ballroom.

Two selections by Poulenc and Tschaiakowsky will feature the orchestra and harpsichord, the latter to be played by C. Lindsley Edson, associate professor of music. Dr. Robert House, head of music, will conduct the orchestra.

The 63 voice Chorale, directed by E. Judith Knowles, instructor in music, will present numbers by da Palestrina, DeLassus, Warrell and an arrangement by Dawson.

The 59 voice concert choir, directed by Allen Downs, assistant professor of music, will present numbers by Shaw, Bach, Fissinger, Booth, Duddy and others. William Lavato, Eveleth, and David Nordland, Duluth will be trumpeters in "Fanfare for Christmas Day."

The choir and chorale will join in "Christmas Day" by Holst to conclude the program. David Dahlgren, Duluth, will be organist.
