Duluth-- Fall hours for UMD's Marshall W. Alworth Planetarium and Darling Observatory have been announced by Professor Donald H. Jackson, director of both facilities.

After Sept. 15, the Planetarium program will be presented at 7:30 p.m. on Mondays and Wednesdays. The Observatory will be opened at dark each Tuesday and Thursday evening.

Jackson also noted that a Stereophonic Sound System and a special Azimuth Pedestal have been installed in the recently opened planetarium. "These additions will add new dimensions to our programs at the planetarium," he said.

The Planetarium is situated on the UMD campus, just off College Street. The Observatory is located at 901 West Third Street.
