LIFE SCIENCE BUILDING-----Word was received Tuesday, April 26, that a Higher Education Facilities grant of \$427,000 has been made to UMD. These funds combined with an appropriation from the 1965 Legislature assure construction of a new \$1,280,000 Life Science Building. The new structure will be located between the Science and Mathematics Building and the new Marshall W. Alworth Planetarium. (R. W. Darland)

RESEARCH-----Grants-in-Aid of research were recently awarded by the Graduate School to Richard W. Ojakangas and Donald M. Davidson for studies of local geological problems. Dr. Ojakangas' research problem is entitled, "Sedimentation of Precambrian sandstones of the western Lake Superior area," and Dr. Davidson will be working on a "Study of the mineralogical character and tectonic significance of sandstone dikes in the Keweenawan lava flows along the North Shore of Lake Superior" and on "Adaption of Fortran program for factor and vector analysis of geologic data using an IBM 1620 computer system."

HISTORICAL SOCIETY LECTURE-----Mr. Arch Gran, Museum Curator of the State Historical Society will present an illustrated lecture to the public at 8:00 p.m. Thursday, May 5, in Education 90 on "The Trails Leading to York Factory," a story of the fur trade and how modern man can retrace the route.
