

DULUTH. . . University of Minnesota Regents' citations were presented Thursday to Bernice Tweed Brickson and Royal D. Alworth, both of Duluth, at a luncheon at Kirby Student Center on the UMD campus.

Regent Richard L. Griggs, Duluth, presented the citation to Mrs. Brickson for her contribution to the University which "was of major significance in making possible the Tweed Gallery on the Duluth campus" . . . for her appreciation of the arts which "was a guiding factor in the establishment of this new center for the cultural advancement of Duluth" . . . and for her efforts on behalf of the student body and staff which "are expressive of her regard for Minnesota's youth of today and tomorrow."

UMD Provost Raymond W. Darland presented the citation to Mr. Alworth for his gift of his home and substantial additional property which "represents major contributions to the University of Minnesota" . . . for his contribution of equipment for the Kirby Student Center at UMD which "has provided a significant service for students and staff" . . . and for "his continuing interest in promoting the economic and intellectual well being of Minnesota youth."

The Alworth property is being used at UMD as a Home Management House by the Home Economics department and for staff apartments.

Dr. Darland congratulated Mrs. Brickson and Mr. Alworth on behalf of students and staff "for your untiring efforts in promoting the cause of higher education both on the UMD campus and in Northeastern Minnesota."
