Duluth--- Arthur D. Hendrickson, instructor in education at UMD, is the author of an article in the December issue of the Minnesota Journal of Education.

The article is titled "Fellowship Program Helps Experienced Elementary Teachers on Their Return to the Classroom."

The author describes the Experienced Teacher Fellowship Program in science and mathematics held at UMD during the 1966-67 school year. Hendrickson describes some of the problems the 22 participating teachers and instructors encountered during the program and the resulting solutions.

Two follow-up studies have been made since the teachers returned to their own schools in order to determine if the program was effective and useful. A final study is being made this year.

Hendrickson, who continues as an evaluator for the program, received his B.S. degree from UMD and the Master of Arts degree from the U. of M., Minneapolis. Before coming to UMD, he taught high school mathematics, physics and chemistry.
