Odor's 12 Points Lead Minnesota Crookston in 89-49 Exhibition Loss to South Dakota State



BROOKINGS, S.D. – The University of Minnesota Crookston women's basketball team opened up exhibition play with a 89-49 loss to NCAA Division I foe South Dakota State University, a 2015-16 NCAA Tournament participant. The game was played Thursday at Frost Arena in Brookings, S.D.

Minnesota Crookston was led by their play inside. [Isieoma Odor](#) (R-So., F/C, Bloomington, Minn.) finished with 12 points on 6-of-18 from the field, and added five boards. [Emily Gruber](#) (Jr., F/C, Monticello, Minn.) chipped in 10 points and added five boards.

In addition to their play inside, [Alison Hughes](#) (So., G, Janesville, Wis.) chipped in 10 points, including going 2-of-3 from beyond the arc. [Caitlin Michaelis](#) (So., G, Marshfield, Wis.) added seven points.

[Leanna Haugen](#) (R-Fr., F/C, Argyle, Minn.) added five points and seven boards off the bench. [Micaela Noga](#) (Jr., G, Parkers Prairie, Minn.) chipped in three points and four boards, while [Kitri Zezza](#) (Fr., G, Albertville, Minn.) added two points.

Minnesota Crookston was 19-of-60 from the field for 31.7 percent. In addition, they were 4-of-18 for 22.2 percent from beyond the arc. UMC was narrowly out-rebounded by the Jackrabbits 50-47.

South Dakota State, who returned all of their starters from last season's Summit League Championship squad, shot 38.0 percent from the field (30-of-79). The Jackrabbits would have four players in double-figures. They were led by 17 points from Clarissa Ober, who was 4-of-6 from the field. Ober added nine boards. Ellie Thompson would chip in 16 points.

Madison Guebert would add 12 points and go 3-of-7 from beyond the arc, while Macy Miller added 11 points.

The Jackrabbits would shoot 6-of-25 from beyond the arc for 24.0 percent. They would go 23-of-30 for 76.7 percent from the charity stripe.

The Golden Eagles would be down just 41-31 to the Jackrabbits at the break as they kept the game close. However, a 9-2 run to open the half would put UMC up 50-33 early in the third quarter. South Dakota State would continue a big third quarter and would lead 72-42 going into the fourth quarter. The Jackrabbits would hold on to their lead and come away with the 89-49 exhibition win.

Minnesota Crookston will return to play in their second exhibition of the season Nov. 6 at 7 p.m. at University of North Dakota.
