Thirteen acts have been auditioned and accepted for the annual student show, according to Varsity Show chairman James Main, Duluth. Robert Devlin, Duluth, will be master of ceremonies and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, the men's music fraternity, will form the stage band.

Campus social and service organizations have arranged 10 group skits along with individual comedian and vocalist routines. Cast members of the upcoming UMD Theater production "The Boy Friend" will present a 15-minute excerpt from the musical comedy.
