Duluth--- The highest winter quarter enrollment in UMD's history---3,608 undergraduate students---was announced today by Provost Raymond W. Darland.

The total is 530 higher than one year ago, a 17% increase. This matches the fall quarter percentage increase, the first time this has ever happened at UMD.

Thirty-six graduate students bring the overall UMD winter quarter total to 3,644.

Total enrollment for the entire University of Minnesota is 36,473 students, an increase of 3,372 or 10% above the 1964 winter figure, according to True E. Pettengill, University recorder.

He said 1,297 new students entered the University this winter quarter compared to 1,277 a year ago. Included in the current total are 24,670 men and 11,803 women.
