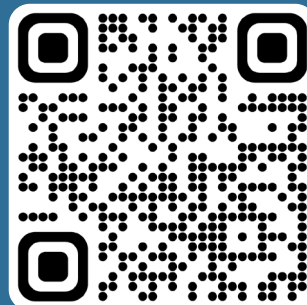

Emily Woster is an Assistant Professor in the Department of English, Linguistics, and Writing Studies, and she serves as the Lead Consultant in the Writers' Workshop.

Working with project partners at the University of Prince Edward Island and the Confederation Centre of the Arts in Charlottetown, P.E.I., Emily Woster curated a new online exhibit that shares, for the first time, the fully digitized manuscript of L.M. Montgomery's classic novel, *Anne of Green Gables* (1908). Emily and the rest of the project team spent the last two years building the site, writing hundreds of annotations to go with the manuscript text, incorporating hundreds of images and audio/video clips, and editing contextual articles from dozens of scholars and experts. Emily will share a behind-the-scenes look at the creation of the exhibit along with lessons learned about writing in/for digital humanities projects.
