DULUTH -- Violinist Judith Askeland and soprano Pamella Smith, both Duluthians, will present a UMD Student Recital at 8:15 p.m. Tuesday (May 16) in the Humanities building Recital Hall.

The recital is open to the public. Admission is free.

Miss Askeland will play the final two movements of the Beethoven "Violin Concerto in D Major" and a Prokofieff "Sonata for Violin and Piano in D Major." Gary Cheezig of Coleraine and Dr. Shirley A. Munger, associate professor of music, will provide piano accompaniment.

Miss Smith will sing a group of Early English Ayres with harpsichord accompaniment by Sharon Hill, Duluth. She also will sing the "Seven Early Song" by Alban Berg, a contemporary German composer.

The recitalists, with Miss Hill on harpsichord, then will join forces in presenting two arias from cantatas by Johann Sebastian Bach as their final numbers.
