

DULUTH--Workshops for elementary school teachers in science and arithmetic will be held in Kirby Student center ballroom and adjacent conference areas Monday (July 28) through Aug. 8, at UMD.

The science workshop will be held July 28 through Aug. 1, and the arithmetic, Aug. 4-8. UMD and the University of Minnesota Center for Continuation Study are sponsoring the sessions.
