Stop by the Welcome Center (Kiehle 116) and pick up your sugar beet sticker while supplies last.

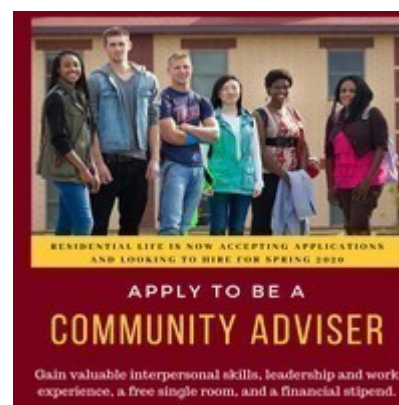

The winner of our drawing for the grand prize was **Ashley Krueger**.

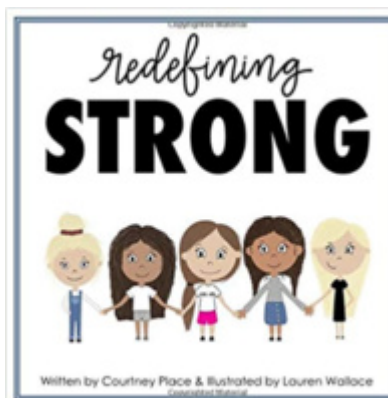




Junior Lauren Wallace Illustrates Children's Book

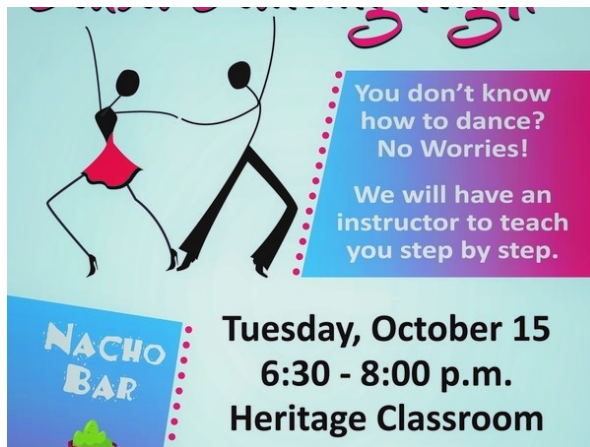

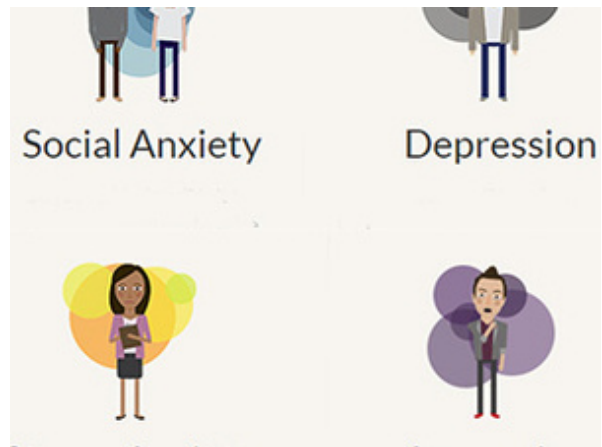
