DULUTH--Lt.Col. Robert W. Tindall, Air Force chaplain from Maxwell AFB., Ala., will visit the UMD ROTC detachment Thursday and Friday. (Oct. 5 and 6)

Col. Tindall will talk to cadets on "The Moral Responsibility of Air Force Officers," observe an Air Science leadership laboratory, meet with detachment personnel and with campus religious advisers. ROTC officials have arranged a tour of Duluth and the Duluth Air Base.

Chaplain Tindall is a graduate of the War College, Air University, Maxwell AFB and received the honorary Doctor of Divinity degree from Jackson College, Honolulu, Hawaii. He is an ordained minister of the Disciples of Christ Church.

He served with the 442nd Troop Carrier Group in Europe during World War II, was staff chaplain of the 25th Air Division, and Air Force Liaison Chaplain of Arlington National Cemetery.

He received the "Four Chaplains Award" in 1953 and the Air Force Commendation Ribbon in 1959.

Local principals on hand to host Tindall will be Lt. Col. Harold Hopkins, professor of Air Force ROTC, and Base Chaplain Capt. John I. Hargrafen, according to Lt. Andrew Sherling, UMD ROTC information officer.
