Declaration of Geneva

At the time of being admitted as a member of the medical profession:—

- I SOLEMNLY PLEDGE myself to consecrate my life to the service of humanity.
- I WILL GIVE to my teachers the respect and gratitude which is their due;
- I WILL PRACTICE my profession with conscience and dignity;
- THE HEALTH OF MY PATIENT will be my first consideration;
- I WILL RESPECT the secrets which are confided in me;
- I WILL MAINTAIN by all the means of my power, the honor and the noble traditions of the medical profession;
- MY COLLEAGUES will be my brothers;
- I WILL NOT PERMIT considerations of religion, nationality, race, party politics or social standing to intervene between my duty and my patient;
- I WILL MAINTAIN the utmost respect for human life, from the time of conception; even under threat, I will not use my medical knowledge contrary to the laws of humanity.
- I MAKE THESE PROMISES solemnly, freely and upon my honor.
