DULUTH--A firearms safety class, conducted by UMD ROTC Commander Lt. Col. Harold J. Hopkins, will be offered to teenagers beginning Monday (April 2), 3:30-5 p.m. at Woodland Junior High School.

The classes, leading to a State Firearms Safety Certificate, are open to youngsters 12 to 16 years of age. Any boy or girl who will be 12 years old by next Oct. 15 is eligible.

The State Firearms Safety Certificate is awarded in lieu of a small game license.

Classes will meet until the school year ends. At least seven meetings are scheduled and will include training films, lectures, firing at the Armory range, a written state examination and a field trip.
