

DULUTH--UMD bombarded Wisconsin State, Superior, 43-6, Saturday, and yet there is little celebrating being done in the Bulldog football camp.

The quality of the vanquished (Superior) and the next opponent (Northern Michigan) have the UMD coaching staff worried. Superior's Yellowjackets provided very little opposition while the upcoming Wildcats may provide too much.

Coach Frosty Freccasa's Michigan eleven flexed their muscles Saturday with a 35-0 breeze over arch rival Central Michigan.

The romp over Central Michigan and the letterman loaded roster of the Wildcats give Bulldog Coach Jim Malosky good reason for concern. Northern Michigan returns most of the personnel who lost a small college playoff to Lenoir-Ryne on a yardage basis following a 20-20 tie, last fall.

This season Northern boosters are touting the Wildcats as the best among the small colleges in the nation.

Coach Malosky is conceding nothing.

He viewed Saturday's opener as 'a good first game'.

"It gave me a chance to use everyone under game conditions and to gain the kind of polish only a game can provide" said Malosky.

The Bulldog mentor has had little to say about the upcoming challenge except to point out that the Bulldogs have proven themselves the best in Minnesota small college circles and will be ready.

The conquest of traditional rival Superior was a statistical walkaway for the Bulldogs. The Yellowjackets entered the final quarter with a minus five yards rushing and managed to get onto the plus side with a late splurge. Meanwhile the Bulldogs were running up 296 yards on the ground and another 84 via the airways.
