GOLFERS TAKE THREE-WEEK BREAK – With four tournaments behind them, the golf team is taking a three-week break in the action before heading to California for their final outing of the fall. Minnesota's traditional autumnal-ending competition, the Stanford Women's Intercollegiate is in its 27th year and will be Oct. 25-27 at the Stanford Golf Course in Stanford, Calif.

Minnesota and Indiana are the only Big Ten Conference teams participating in the tournament. Other teams scheduled to compete are Arizona, Brigham Young, Hawaii, New Mexico, New Mexico State, Oregon, San Francisco, San Jose State, Southern Methodist, Stanford, Texas Christian, Texas Tech, Tulsa, UCLA, U.S. International and Washington.

GOPHERS WIN TWO TEAM TITLES – The Gophers have won two of their four tournaments this fall. They topped the field in their home tournament, the Minnesota Invitational, Sept. 15-16, and at the Lady Northern Invitational, Sept. 21-23.

At the Minnesota Invitational, the Gophers carded rounds of 317, 327 and 324 for a team total of 968 strokes. Iowa also shot a 968 54-hole score but finished in second place by tie-breaker rules. In order of their finish, other teams competing were Michigan (985), Nebraska (989), Kansas State (999), Mankato State (1031), Minnesota-Duluth (1060) and Winona State (1080.

A week later at the Lady Northern Invitational, Minnesota easily defeated the field of 15 teams, winning by nine strokes over second-place Indiana. The Gophers shot rounds of 309, 320 and 303 for a total of 932 strokes. The tournament, which was at the Cherokee Club in Madison, Wis., is held on the same course that will host that year's Big Ten Conference Women's Golf Championship May 3-5.

In their first competition of the fall, the team finished in 9th place of 15 teams at the **Lady Tar Heel Invitational**, Sept. 7-9 in Chapel Hill, N.C. The Gophers recorded their best total of the fall at the Lady Tar Heel with rounds of 314, 313 and 301 for a 928 54-hole total. Texas topped the field with a 901 team aggregate.

The Gophers returned to North Carolina for the **Duke Invitational**, Oct. 5-6, at Durham. They were fourth of 13 teams, carding rounds of 322, 316 and 315 for a 953 team total. North Carolina led the field with final score of 913 strokes.

ROSS HAS LOW INDIVIDUAL AVERAGE – Senior captain KELLI ROSS (BURNSVILLE, MN) has the low individual average on the Gopher squad this year with a 77.16 mark, after 12 rounds. At the Lady Northern Invitational, Ross set two collegiate-career personal bests as she finished in third place with rounds of 74, 81 and 73 for a 228 total. Her 73 final-18 hole score bettered her previous low mark by one stroke as as did her 54-hole total of 228.

In earlier season outings, Ross tied for 18th-place at the Lady Tar Heel with rounds of 79, 75, and 75 for a 229 stroke total, was second at the Minnesota Invitational with marks of 67-78-77 for 231 strokes, and shot an 82, 79 and 77 for a 238-stroke, 17th-place finish at the Duke Invitational.

EVENS CARRYING 77+ AVERAGE- Sophomore SARA EVENS (GRAFTON, ND) has the second-lowest individual average on the team this fall with 77.75 strokes after 12 rounds of play. Her best finish of the year came at the Lady Tar Heel when she carded rounds of 75, 76 and 72 for a 223-stroke total for a third place tie. Evens was 8th at the Minnesota Invitational with rounds of 81, 83 and 81 for 245 strokes.

Evens dropped 15 strokes from her game a week later at the Lady Northern where she carded a 76, 78 and 76 for a 230-stroke total and sixth place. Most recently, Evens finished in a 12th-place tie after shooting a 78, 80 and 77 for a 235 final score at the Duke Invitational.

Golf Week magazine chose Evens as a pre-season all-American honorable mention for the 1990-91 season. Evens carried a 79.21 stroke average as a freshman and was the medalist at the Penn State Invitational last fall.

LEIGHTON EAGLES TWICE THIS FALL – Sophomore KRIS LEIGHTON (AUSTIN, MN) has eagled twice this season, both times on the 18th hole. Her first eagle came at home during the first round of the Minnesota Invitational when she chipped to the 18th green on her third stroke, sinking the ball on the par-5, 406-yard hole at the University of Minnesota Les Bolstad Golf Course. During the final round at the Lady Northern, Leighton drilled the ball on her second stroke into the cup from 200 yards out with a five-wood. This was on the par-4, 366-yard 18th-hole at the Cherokee Country Club in Madison, Wis.

Leighton, who is playing the best golf of her collegiate career, has a season average of 79.58 strokes per round. At the Lady Tar Heel, she shot a 76, 81 and 78 for a 235 total and a tie for 36th-place. At the Minnesota Invitational, she tied for 25th place with an 83, 91 and 77 for a 257 aggregate.

At the Lady Northern, Leighton had three collegiate personal bests in addition to her eagle. She recorded her low 18-hole score (71), low 54-hole score (227) and best-tournament finish after she ended in second place with rounds of 76, 80 and 71 for a 227-stroke total. Leighton continued her strong shooting at the Duke Invitational when she tied for 14th-place after carding 77, 82 and 77 for a score of 236 strokes.

REUTERFELDT ON PAR WITH LAST SEASON – Junior KRISTA REUTERFELDT's (COON RAPIDS, MN) scoring this fall is similar to her average from a year ago. She is averaging one-stroke more per round this fall than she was a year ago. After competing in three tournaments, Reuterfeldt has an 82.33 stroke average, compared with an 81.33 this time last year.

Each tournament this fall has seen a three-stroke improvement over the previous one for Reuterfeldt. After carding a 78, 87 and 85 for a 250 total at the Minnesota Invitational for 15th-place tie, she shot an 83, 81 and 83 for 247 strokes for a 42nd-place tie at the Lady Northern. In her next tournament, the Duke Fall Invitational, Reuterfeldt dropped her final score by three more strokes when she carded an 85, 74 and 84 for a 244-stroke total and a 20th-place tie.

TRACI JOHNSON SHOWS IMPROVEMENT – Senior TRACI JOHNSON (MARSHALL, MN) has improved her golf game by over a stroke as compared with last year's season average. Currently, Johnson has an 83.44 stroke average after ending the the 1989-90 season with 84.68 mark.

Along with the improved average, Johnson has set three collegiate-person bests this fall. She carded her low 18-hole score of 79 at the Minnesota Invitational and low 54-hole score of 246 at the Lady Tar Heel tournament. At the Lady Tar Heel she carded an 84, 81 and 81 for the 246 total and a tie for 73rd place. At the Minnesota Invitational she shot an 82, 79 and 92 for 253 strokes and a 20th-place tie which is her highest finish as a Gopher. At the Lady Northern, Johnson tied for 52nd place with an 88, 81 and 83 for a 252-stroke total.

WOLLACK STARTS COLLEGIATE CAREER – Redshirt freshman CHRIS WOLLACK (DULUTH, MN/ HERMANTOWN) opened her collegiate career at the Lady Tar Heel Invitational and carded an 88, 83 and 76 for a three-round total of 247 strokes and a tie at 75th-place. Wollack, who is academically a sophomore, didn't compete last year and has three more years of eligibility after this season. In her only other start of the year, Wollack shot a 90, 82 and 90 for 262 strokes for a 29th-place tie at the Minnesota Invitational.

ERDMANN A REGULAR STARTER – Freshman JANA ERDMANN (LEWISTON-ALTURA) has earned a starting spot in two of the tournaments Minnesota has competed in and has played in a third as an individual competitor. Erdmann played in the Lady Northern Invitational where she was 71st with rounds of 89, 88 and 86 for a 263 stroke total. She also competed in the Duke Invitational where she shot a 94, 84 and 87 for 265 strokes and a 50th-place tie. At the Minnesota Invitational, Erdmann shot her best rounds of the fall while competing as an individual. She tied for 18th place with an 82, 86 and 84 for a 252 total.

ONE TOURNAMENT EACH - Sophomore SARA JOHNSON (ROSEAU, MN) and freshman LISA HANSON (FOSSTON, MN) have each seen action once this season, both playing in the Minnesota Invitational. Hanson competed as a individual, tying for 27th place with a total of 259 strokes after recording rounds of 82, 89 and 88. Johnson competed as a Minnesota team member and finished in a tie for 36th place after rounds of 90, 96 and 83 for a total of 269 strokes.

SEASON FINALE FOR GOLFERS IN SUNNY CALIFORNIA

Playing under sunny California skies and warm temperatures, the Minnesota women's golf team finished their fall season at the Stanford Intercollegiate tournament Oct. 25-27. Minnesota carded rounds of 310, 315 and 310 for a 54-hole total of 935 strokes. The Gophers finished in 10th-place in the field of 18 teams. Arizona won the tournament with an 885 team total on the par 73, 6,190-yard Stanford Golf Course. San Jose State's Pat Hurst, who won the 1989 NCAA women's golf championship on the same course, was the medalist with a total of 212 strokes.

After five tournaments and 15 rounds of play this fall, Minnesota has a 314.20 team stroke average. The Gophers won both the Minnesota Invitational and the Lady Northern Invitational, while finishing fourth at the Duke Invitational and ninth at the Lady Tary Heel.

EVENS TOP GOPHER AT STANFORD – The Gophers were led by sophomore SARA EVENS (GRAFTON, ND), who carded rounds of 74, 76 and 78 for a three-day total of 228 strokes and a 20th-place tie at the Stanford Intercollegiate tournament. Evens completed the fall season with the second lowest stroke average on the squad with 77.40 strokes per round.

ROSS HAS BEST AVERAGE ON TEAM – Senior KELLI ROSS (BURNSVILLE, MN) has the best average on the team this fall with 77.00 strokes per round. Ross, who recorded 12 of her 15 rounds this fall in the 70's, is in seventh place in the Gopher record book in the low fall season average category. Ross' former teammate Kate Hughes has the lowest fall season average for Minnesota with 75.00 strokes per round. At the Stanford Intercollegiate tournament, Ross finished in a tie for 25th-place after recording rounds of 74, 80 and 75 for a total of 229 strokes.

REUTERFELDT HAS HER BEST OUTING OF YEAR – Junior KRISTA REUTERFELDT (COON RAPIDS, MN) had her lowest score of the year at the Stanford tournament with rounds of 77, 79 and 77 for a 54-hole total of 233, tying for 34th-place overall. Reuterfeldt has a fall average of 81.17 strokes per round after playing in four of the five tournaments Minnesota competed in this fall.

LEIGHTON PLAYS IN EVERY TOURNEY – Sophomore KRIS LEIGHTON (AUSTIN, MN) was only one of three Gophers to play in all five fall tournaments, ending the fall with an 80.26 stroke average. At the Stanford Intercollegiate tournament, Leighton tied for 71st-place after carding rounds of 85, 80 and 84 for a 249-stroke total.

ERDMANN HAS BEST HER BEST FINISH OF THE FALL – Freshman JANA ERDMANN (LEWSITON, MN) recorded the best finish of her short collegiate career after rounds of 88, 82 and 80 for a 250-stroke score at the Stanford Intercollegiate tournament, tying for 73rd place. Her previous best was a score of 252 strokes which she shot at the Minnesota Invitational in mid-September. Erdmann has a fall season stroke average of 85.83 strokes per round after playing in four the five fall tournaments.

GOLF SEASON UNDER WAY DOWN SOUTH IN DIXIE

Due to the constraints of the Great White North (ie:snow and sleet), the 27th-ranked Minnesota women's golf team is competing way down south in Dixie this spring. Before the Big Ten championships in May, Minnesota will play in Alabama twice, Texas and Arizona. The Gophers will move just north of the Mason-Dixon Line when they compete in Columbus at the Ohio State Invitational in mid-April.

TOURNAMENTS PAST – The golfers have already been in the field twice this season, first when they had their winter training trip in Texas and most recently, in Alabama. At the Auburn/Country Club of America Intercollegiate tournament March 1-3, Minnesota finished in fifth place after carding rounds of 327 and 322 for a 36-hole total of 649 strokes. The tournament was scheduled for 54 holes of play, but was rained out the final day. South Carolina won the Auburn tournament after shooting a total of 612 strokes. During the winter training trip to Texas, Minnesota won an 18-hole dual meet with the Texas-El Paso Feb. 22, 334 strokes to 337 strokes.

EVENS LEADS TEAM – Sophomore SARA EVENS (GRAFTON, ND) has the led the Gophers in both of their spring outings, winning the dual meet with UTEP after shooting an 18-hole of score of 81 stokes. This is the second collegiate win for Evens, with her first one coming in the fall of 1989 at the Penn State Lady Lion Invitational. She was the top Gopher at the Auburn tournament with a tie for third place after recording rounds of 75 and 79 for a 36-hole total of 154 strokes. This spring Evens has a 78.33 stroke average and an overall average of 77.56 strokes per round.

ROSS HAS 78.22 SEASON AVERAGE – Senior KELLI ROSS (BURNSVILLE, MN) has a season stroke average of 78.22, the second best on the team. At UTEP, Ross finished second in the tourney with an 18-hole score of 82. She tied for 25th place at the Auburn/Country Club of America Intercollegiate tournament with rounds of 86 and 80 for a final score of 166 strokes.

MARSHALL'S JOHNSON THIRD AT UTEP - Senior TRACI JOHNSON (MARSHALL, MN) had her collegiate-career best finish at the UTEP-Minnesota dual meet with an 18-hole score of 85. At the Auburn tournament, Johnson tied for 27th-place with rounds of 85 and 84 for a 169 strokes. She has a spring season average of 84.67 strokes and an overall average of 83.75 strokes per round.

LEIGHTON LOWERS SCORE EVERY ROUND – Sophomore KRIS LEIGHTON (AUSTIN, MN) has been lowering her score with each round she has played this spring. At the dual meet with UTEP, Leighton carded an 86-stroke round for fourth place. Her next round of play came at the Auburn/Country Club of America Intercollegiate tournament when she carded an 81. Her final round at Auburn dropped by two strokes to give her a score a 79 for the day and a total of 160 strokes for a tied at 17th place. Leighton has an overall stroke average of 80.56 strokes per round.

ERDMANN IN THE FIELD TWICE – Freshman JANA ERDMANN (LEWISTON, MN) has competed in both of the Gophers' outings this spring. At the UTEP-Minnesota dual meet she carded an 18-hole score of 98. She improved vastly at the Auburn/Country Club of America Intercollegiate tournament, cutting her score by 12 and 14 strokes per round. Erdmann carded rounds of 86 and 84 for a 36-hole total of 170 strokes and has a season stroke average of 86.53 strokes.

REUTERFELDT COMPETED AT UTEP – Junior KRISTA REUTERFELDT (COON RAPIDS, MN) has seen action once this, playing in the UTEP-Minnesota dual meet where she carded an eighth-place score of 96. Reuterfeldt has a season average of 82.31 strokes per round.

GOPHERS IMPROVE WITH EACH TOURNAMENT

The team per round scoring average of the Minnesota women's golf team has improved by four strokes in the last three tournaments. The Gophers, with a 329.80 per round stroke-average after the March 21-22 Desert Challenge, dropped their stroke average by over three strokes at the South Carolina Women's Invitational, March 29-31. The final improvement, making it four strokes even, came at the Lady Buckeye Spring Invitational, April 13-14 when Minnesota lowered its per round average score to 325.80.

During that same time, Minnesota jumped in team standings from finishing among the bottom 20 percent of the teams in a tournament to the top 20 percent. At the Desert Challenge, the Gophers were fourth of five teams with rounds of 327 and 322 for a total of 666 strokes. They moved to the middle of the pack at the South Carolina invitational with a seventh-place finish after recording rounds of 324, 312 and 326 for a 54-hole total of 962 strokes. At the 16-team Lady Buckeye tournament, Minnesota finished in third place after rounds of 326 and 321 for a 36-hole total of 647 strokes.

EVENS HAS LOW TEAM AVERAGE – Sophomore SARA EVENS (GRAFTON, ND) has the lowest spring season average on the team with 78.90 strokes per round. Evens has finished among the top three players in two of her last three outings. At the Desert Challenge, Evens tied for third place after carding rounds of 82 and 81 for 163 strokes. Although her play improved by over a two-stroke average per round at the South Carolina Women's Invitational, Evens finished in 37th-place with scores of 79, 76 and 82 for 237 strokes. Evens jumped to second place from 13th at the Lady Buckeye Spring Invitational with rounds of 79 and 75 for a total of 237 strokes.

ERDMANN HAS PERSONAL BEST TOURNAMENT - Freshman JANA ERDMANN (LEWISTON, MN) set three personal collegiate-best marks at the Lady Buckeye Spring Invitational. She carded rounds of 77 and 79 for 156 strokes and a fourth place finish. Erdmann's opening round 77 was three strokes lower than her previous best 18-hole score and was the result of having five birdies. Her 36-hole total of 156 strokes was 13 strokes below her previous low mark of 169 strokes. The final new mark came in Erdmann's overall tournament finish of fourth place. Her previous best finish was ninth place.

At the Desert Challenge, Erdmann tied for 15th place after rounds of 88 and 81 for 169 strokes. She was 44th at the South Carolina Women's Invitational after scores of 84, 81, 81 for 246 strokes. Erdmann has a 83.90 spring stroke average.

JOHNSON IN THIRD TOURNAMENT - Senior TRACI JOHNSON (MARSHALL, MN) played in her third tournament of the spring season at the Lady Buckeye Invitational. She carded rounds of 92 and 85 for a 36-hole total of 177 strokes and 56th-place. Johnson has a 84.43 season stroke average.

LEIGHTON BREAKS FINGER – Sophomore KRIS LEIGHTON (AUSTIN, MN) broke the ring finger on her right hand the day before the start of the Lady Buckeye Spring Invitational after getting it caught in the door of the team's van. Leighton played the first round of the tournament, carding an 86, but withdrew from the final round. She is sitting out the April 19-21 tournament at South Alabama, but is expected to compete at the Big Ten championship, May 3-5.

At the Desert Challenge, Leighton had rounds of 85 and 82 for 167 strokes for a tie at 11th place. She tied for 51st place at the South Carolina Women's Invitational with a 54-hole total of 252 strokes after recording rounds of 85, 79 and 88. She is carrying an 81.46 stroke average for the year.

REUTERFELDT STRUGGLING - Junior KRISTA REUTERFELDT (COON RAPIDS, MN) has been struggling with her game this spring. She has a spring stroke average of 88.67 strokes per round as compared with an 83.67 fall season-stroke average. At the Desert Challenge, Reuterfeldt had rounds of 89 and 85 for a 174-stroke total and 22nd place. She tied for 59th place at the South Carolina Women's Invitational after rounds of 87, 90 and 85 for 262 strokes.

ROSS TOP GOPHER AT SOUTH CAROLINA – Senior KELLI ROSS (BURNSVILLE, MN) was the top finishing Gopher at the South Carolina Women's Invitational with a tie for eighth place. Ross had rounds of 76, 76 and 78 for 230 strokes. It was the first time this spring, but the third time this year that she has recorded all three rounds in the 70's. At the Desert Challenge, Ross tied for 25th place with scores of 80 and 86 for 166 strokes. At the Lady Buckeye Spring Invitational, she shot scores of 84 and 82 for 166 strokes, which placed her 24th in the field of 84 golfers.

JOHNSON RECORDS PERSONAL-BEST GOLF SEASON

(Minneapolis, Minn.) -- Marshall High School graduate (1987) Traci Johnson recorded her personal-best year as a member of the University of Minnesota women's golf team. Johnson competed is six of the Gopher's 12 tournaments this year, playing in three contests in each of the fall and spring seasons.

During the year, Johnson had career-best marks in six categories:

- recorded her low 18-hole score of 79 strokes at the Minnesota Invitational, 9/16/90;
- recorded her low 36-hole score of 169 strokes at the Auburn Invitational, 3/3/911;
- recorded her low 54-hole score of 246 strokes at the Lady Tar Heel Invitational, 9/9/90:
- had her lowest fall composite stroke average of 84.95 strokes per round;
- had her lowest combined fall-spring stroke average of 84.43 strokes per round;
- had her best placing at a tournament with a third-place finish at a dual meet the University of Texas-El Paso (UTEP) in February.

Johnson's best tournament this year was the 18-hole UTEP dual meet on Feb. 22, where she carded an 85 for a third-place finish. At the Auburn Invitational March 1-3, she had rounds of 85 and 84 for 169 strokes and a 27th-place tie. During the fall season, when the Gophers hosted the Minnesota Invitational Sept. 15-16, Johnson had rounds of 82, 79 and 92 for 253 strokes and a 20th-place finish.

Johnson, who redshirted her freshman year as a Gopher, has a three-year collegiate career fall stroke average of 84.95, a spring stroke average of 86.93 and season average of 85.84 strokes per round.

A speech communication major, Johnson is the daughter of Randall and Deb Johnson of Marshall.





At the South Alabama Intercollegiate Championship on April 21, Erdmann carded a first round 75 for her varsity low 18-hole score. Overall all at the South Alabama tournament, Erdmann carded rounds of 75, 82, and 84 for her collegiate-low 54-hole score of 241 strokes.

At the Big Ten Women's Golf Championship that concluded May 5, all four of Erdmann's rounds counted towards Minnesota's team score. She recorded scores of 85, 77, 80 and 81 for 342 strokes for a 23rd-place tie.

Erdmann, the daughter of Wayne and Ellen Erdmann of Lewiston, has not yet declared a major.

EVENS BECOMES NINTH GOLFER WITH TWO VICTORIES

(Minneapolis, Minn.) -- Grafton High School graduate (1989) Sara Evens became only the ninth University of Minnesota golfer to win two collegiate-career tournaments. After earning her second win on Feb. 22 at the Minnesota-Texas-El Paso dual meet with an 81. The meet was in conjunction with Minnesota's winter training trip. Evens' first career medalist honors came one year ago at the Lady Buckeye Spring Invitational at Ohio State.

Evens concluded the year with a 78.16 season stroke average after having a 77.00 fall average and a 78.82 spring stroke average. During the year, Evens finished among the top 10 golfers in seven of the 12 tournaments the Gophers competed in during the season.

She was second at the Lady Buckeye Spring Invitational on March 31 after carding rounds of 79 and 75 for 154 strokes, which is her collegiate-low 36-hole total. Evens had three third-place finishes during the year, with the first coming at the Lady Tar Heel Invitational in September where she had rounds of 75, 76 and 72 for 223 strokes. This spring, she had back-to-back third place finishes at the Auburn Invitational on March 3 and the Desert Challenge on March 22. At Auburn, Evens carded a 75 and 79 for 154 strokes and at the Minnesota and Iowa-hosted Desert Challenge, she recorded a two-round total of 163 strokes.

At this year's Big Ten Women's Golf Championship, May 3-5, Evens tied for 12th-place with rounds of 76, 83, 79 and 77 for 315 strokes. She was just one stroke away from tying her collegiate personal-best 72-hole score of 314 strokes.

Evens was a *Golf Week* 1990-91 pre-season all-American honorable mention pick and was the *Minnesota Daily* Athlete of the Week for the week of April 15. Evens has not yet decided upon a major and is the daughter of Morris and Judy Evens of Grafton, ND.



LEIGHTON SETS FOUR PERSONAL BESTS AS A SOPHOMORE

(Minneapolis, Minn.) -- University of Minnesota sophomore Kris Leighton, a 1989 graduate of Austin High School, set four personal-best marks this year as a member of women's golf team. Three of the personal bests were recorded at the Lady Northern Invitational in Madison, Wis., Sept. 14-16.

Leighton carded her collegiate personal-low 18-hole round of 71 strokes during the third round of the tournament which was held at the Cherokee Country Club in Madison, Wis. Contributing to the her score of 71 was the eagle she recorded on the par-4, 18th hole. Leighton, using a five-wood, drilled the cup from 200 yards out on the 366-yard link for her second eagle of the season. She had 227 strokes for the tournament for her collegiate low 54-hole score. Leighton finished in second place for her best collegiate-career finish. At the Minnesota Invitational, Leighton also eagled the par-5, 406-yard 18th hole of the University of Minnesota Les Bolstad Golf Course.

Three weeks before the Big Ten championship this spring, a freak accident put a squeeze on Leighton's season. On April 12, the evening before the start of the Lady Buckeye Spring Invitational in Columbus, Ohio, Leighton broke the ring finger of her right hand after getting it caught in the door of team's van. She played the first round of the Lady Buckeye, carding an 86, but had to withdraw from the final round due to pain, and trouble chipping and putting because of the cast on her finger.

Leighton sat out the next tournament and then was in the field at the Big Ten Women's Golf Championship in Madison, May 3-5. With her finger still immobilized, Leighton had rounds of 83, 81, 87 and 88 for 339 strokes. For the year, she had a season stroke average of 81.93 strokes after having a fall average of 80.27 strokes and an 83.85 spring stroke average.

Leighton is a pre-psychology major and is the daughter of Robert and JoAnn Leighton of Austin, Minn.

REUTERFELDT STRUGGLES DURING JUNIOR YEAR

(Minneapolis, Minn.) -- Coon Rapids High School graduate (1988) Krista Reuterfeldt struggled this spring as a member of the University of Minnesota women's golf team. She had a spring stroke of 86.30 strokes per round which was more than six strokes higher than last year's spring average of 79.81.

Reuterfeldt's fall season was her best ever as a collegian with an 81.76 stroke average. Her best tournament of the fall was the Stanford Invitational, which is played on the challenging Stanford Golf Course in Stanford, Cal. She had rounds of 77, 79 and 77 for 233 strokes. It was the third time she had played that course and Reuterfeldt's 233 score was 10 and 13 strokes better than her previous two marks on the course. Over the 25 rounds she played this year, Reuterfeldt averaged 83.88 strokes per round.

A mathematics major, Reuterfeldt is the daughter of Nikki Reuterfeldt of Coon Rapids and James Reuterfeldt of Seminole, Fla.

ROSS HAS BEST YEAR OF HER COLLEGIATE CAREER

(Minneapolis, Minn.) -- Burnsville High School graduate (1987) Kelli Ross had the best year of her collegiate career as a member of the women's golf team at the University of Minnesota. A senior, Ross enters the Minnesota record book for having the seventh-best fall stroke average of 77.00 strokes per round and the ninth-best total season average with 78.31 strokes. She competed in all 12 of the tournaments the Gopher competed in this season.

Finishing among the top 10 golfers in five of the tournaments, Ross had her highest collegiate finish in a tournament at home this past fall. At the Minnesota Invitational on Sept. 16, Ross was second with rounds of 76, 78 and 77 for 231 strokes.
