Cathy ten Broeke is the State of Minnesota's Director to Prevent and End Homelessness. In this role, Cathy oversees the State's response to homelessness by working with multiple state agencies, community partners, and private stakeholders to create a statewide partnership to end homelessness. Cathy has 20 years of experience working on homelessness in both the non-profit and government sectors.

Prior to this position, Cathy was Director of the Minneapolis/Hennepin County Office to End Homelessness where she led the community-wide effort to prevent and end homelessness for men, women, children, and youth in Hennepin County and directed the Minneapolis Project Homeless Connect.

Most recently, Cathy served in the Obama Administration as a Special Advisor to the Executive Director of the United States Interagency Council on Homelessness.

Cathy has a Master's degree in Public Affairs from the University of Minnesota's Humphrey Institute. In addition to her work, Cathy loves documentary photography, her life partner, and her beautiful and energetic 5-year-old son.

## Candidates for Degrees

This program contains the names of College of Design students who have applied to graduate from fall semester 2012 through summer 2013. This is not an official University of Minnesota graduation list.

To graduate with distinction, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher at graduation. To graduate with high distinction, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.90 or higher. Graduation with designated Latin honors (cum laude, magna cum laude, summa cum laude) is limited to students who participate in the University of Minnesota Honors Program. Students must complete honors requirements, including a capstone or thesis project in their major, and, in their last 60 University of Minnesota credits, maintain a 3.50 GPA for cum laude, a 3.66 GPA for magna cum laude, and a 3.75 GPA for summa cum laude honors. Candidates for academic honors are noted in this program.
