DULUTH -- A Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Review course will be offered by UMD's General Extension Division beginning Wednesday, May 11, according to Regional Director Dr. Cyril M. Milbrath.

The purpose of the class is to refresh and update the student's prior accounting knowledge and to emphasize those subject areas regularly covered in the CPA examination.

The instructor will be Robert E. Curtis, UMD assistant professor of business administration. The course will carry six credits and the class will meet from 6-9 p.m.

Following the May 11 orientation course the students will spend the summer in independent study on accounting practices. On September 7 they will return to the classroom for twice weekly (Tuesday and Thursday) sessions in accounting theory, auditing and business law.

The cost of the class is \$75, half of which is due at registration or no later than the May 11 class.

Students planning to take the course should already have completed a degree program with a major in accounting or equivalent or should have at least three years experience in public accounting.
