DULUTH--"Consumer Savings and the United States Savings Bond" will be the topic of Dr. Cecil Meyers, UMD professor of business and economics, when he presents the third Research Trust Fund lecture this year at UMD.

Dr. Meyers will speak at a 12:30 p.m. luncheon April 25 in Kirby Student Center ballroom.

Meyers' report follows a study of personal thrift and savings through periods of war, depression and inflation.

Dr. Meyers came to UMD in 1949 after receiving BA, MA and PH.D. degrees from the State University of Iowa. He has written extensively in the areas of savings bonds, business statistics and business management.
