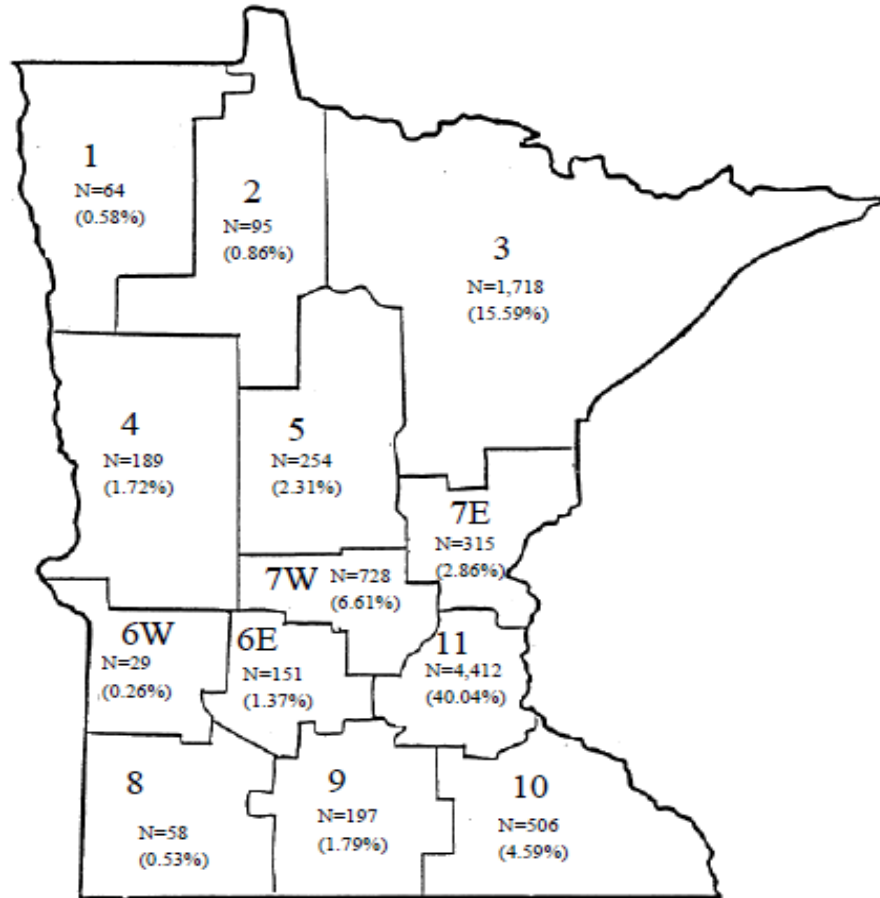

Fall 2016 Headcount Enrollment by Geographic Region



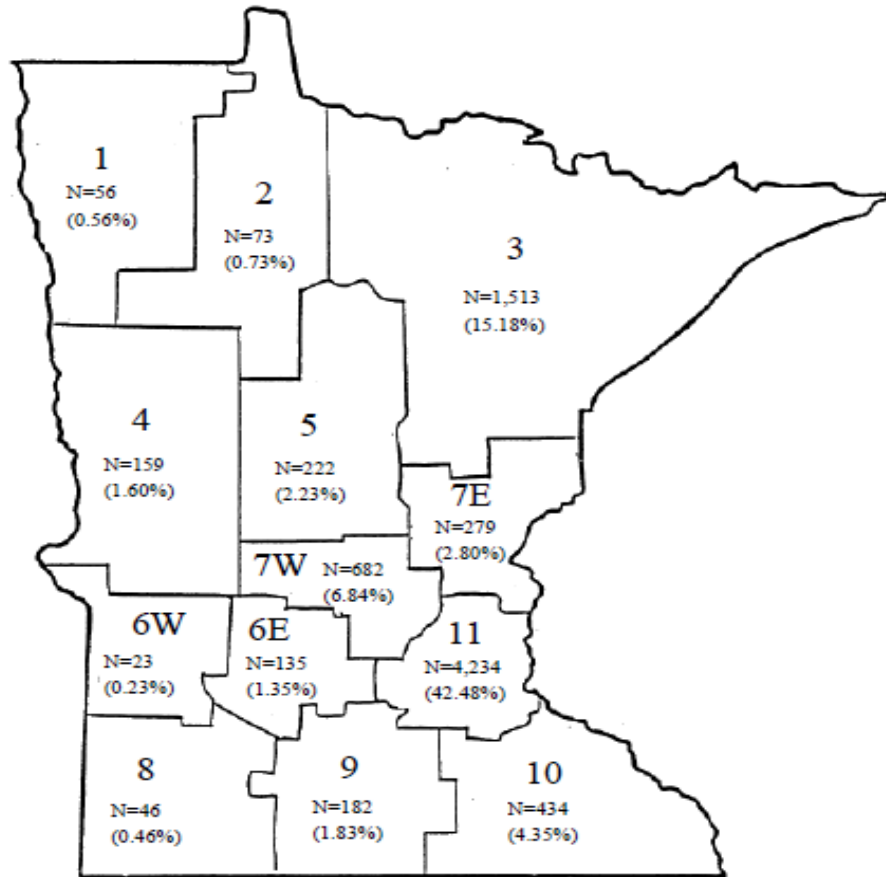
