

DULUTH--UMD's Junior halfback John Nachtsheim renews his assault on the record books Saturday (Oct.14) as the Bulldogs host Gustavus Adolphus in a 2 p.m. Homecoming game.

Nachtsheim, 185-pound speedster from Robbinsdale, has nailed down one mark--career rushing--and is in hot pursuit of five others.

Last week's performance against Augsburg--130 yards rushing--moved the elusive back to the top of the career rushing list with 992 yards over a season and a half. The new mark tops the 882 compiled by Dick Pesonen(1958-59) now a defensive back with the Minnesota Vikings.

Nachtsheim's two touchdown performance raised his season total to 68 and moved him to within striking distance of these scoring records:

All four records could fall Saturday along with the single season rushing mark of 594 held jointly by Pesonen and Jerry Richardson (1960). Nachtsheim has gained 440 yards thus far this season.

Nachtsheim's personal battle Saturday will be a sidelight to the main order of business--UMD vs Gustavus Adolphus.

The once Golden Gusties are struggling along with a 1-2 MIAC mark, while the Bulldogs, who have never defeated a Gustavus team in Duluth, are undefeated in conference play.

Coach Jim Malosky, dissatisfied with last week's defensive effort, has stressed this phase of the game all week. He reports satisfactory progress and indicates everyone is healthy and ready to go.
