DULUTH -- An article entitled "Effect of Electrolyte Environment on Divalent Tartrate Ion Mobility" by James C. Nichol, UMD professor of chemistry, and two of his former students, Duane Heikkinen and Gary Glass, has been published in the May issue of the Canadian Journal of Chemistry.

The issue is dedicated to Professor R. B. Sandin of the University of Alberta on the occasion of his sixty-eighth birthday with articles by his former students.

Dr. Nichol obtained his M.Sc. degree under the direction of Professor Sandin in 1945. Glass and Heikkinen were National Science Foundation undergraduate research participants who worked with Dr. Nichol from 1961-63.
