DULUTH -- The psychopathic Lt. Cmdr Queeg will be played by Larry Nachbar of Duluth in the UMD Summer Theater's production of "The Caine Mutiny Court-Martial" at 8 p.m. Friday and Saturday (July 9-10) in Kirby Student Center ballroom.

"Caine Mutiny" is a late replacement for "A Case of Libel" which had to be cancelled due to a law suit against it. "Libel" is based on the famous court battle between journalists Westbrook Pegler and Quentin Reynolds.

Terrence Markovich of Calumet portrays Lt. Stephen Maryk who relieves Queeg during a typhoon because he believes him to be psychopathic and winds up being charged with mutiny.

John Bailey of Caspian, Michigan is cast as Lt. Greenwald, the defense attorney, Don Barnes of Duluth as Lt. Cmdr John Challee the judge advocate and Don Jensen of Duluth as Capt. Blakely the presiding officer at the trial.

John Crossman of Duluth will appear as Lt. (j.g.) Willis Keith, the young and unsure member of Queeg's shipboard staff. Tom Kovarik of Duluth plays Capt Randolph Southard (an expert on ship handling), James Caine of Duluth as Dr. Forrest Lundeen (a psychiatrist) and Dave Williams of Duluth as Dr. Byrd a young medical doctor.

The cast also includes Tim Dieffenbaker of Grand Rapids as Lt. Thomas Keefer, Doug Moen of Duluth as a signalman, Ann Tamminen of Duluth as the court stenographer, John Westman of Duluth as narrator and Duluthians Ed Siggelkow, Dave Ecker, John Ness and Doug Moeberg as members of the court.

The play is open to the public. Admission is \$1.50.
