## Golden Eagles Fall 11-10 and 7-0 to Concordia-St. Paul



**ST. PAUL, Minn.-** The University of Minnesota Crookston softball team fell 11-10 and 7-0 to Concordia University, St. Paul Saturday afternoon at Carlander Field in St. Paul, Minn. The Golden Eagles had an early 9-2 advantage on the Golden Bears, but Concordia used a single from Lizzy Swenson to drive in Navaræ Honoroff to pick up the 11-10 win.

UMC falls to 4-26 (0-12 NSIC). Concordia improves to 13-22 (7-5 NSIC) with the two victories.

The Golden Bears would get on the board first in the bottom of the first when Haley Schanks belted a two-run home run to drive in Teona Zepeda.

UMC would come back with five runs in the second. [Kaylin Beatty](#) (Jr., OF, Andover, Minn./Animal Science) would single to drive in [Kristi Larson](#) (Jr., IF, New Ulm, Minn./Sports and Rec Management). The Golden Eagles would continue the scoring as [Shelby Hollinger](#) (Sr., 2B, Neudorf, Saskatchewan) hit a grand-slam, her team-leading eighth home run of the year, to drive in herself, [Victoria Bayliss](#) (Fr., OF, West Bloomfield, Mich./Elementary Education), Beatty and [Bailey Braatz](#) (So., RHP, Buffalo, Minn./Sports and Rec Management).

The Golden Eagles would get another grand slam, as [Allison Foley](#) (Jr., SS, Lockport, Ill./Accounting) launched her third home run of the season, to drive in herself, Hollinger, Bayliss and Beatty.

The Golden Bears, down 9-2, would get back four runs in the fourth, led by a Honoroff single to drive in Emily Shinn and Kelly McKenzie to make it 9-6.

UMC would add a run in the top of the fifth as Bayliss scored on a wild pitch.

The Golden Bears would get four in the bottom of the fifth to knot the game up 10-10.

Swenson would get the game-winning hit in the seventh to deliver the win for Concordia.

Stephanie Kappes got the win in relief, going 3.2 innings and giving up two earned runs on five hits.

[Brooke Vatthauer](#) (Sr., LHP, Crookston, Minn./Health Science) would suffer the loss in relief for UMC, going 1.2 innings and giving up one earned run on four hits.

UMC was led by Bayliss, who was 3-of-5 with three runs. Hollinger was 2-of-5 with two runs scored and four RBI's. In game two, UMC's bats would fall victim to Schanks, who would pitch a complete game three-hit shutout for the Golden Bears.

[Jordyn Derflinger](#) (Jr., RHP, Henderson, Nev./Elementary Education) suffered the loss after giving up seven runs, three of them earned, on seven hits.

[Sammy Knudson](#) (So., RHP, Fergus Falls, Minn./Health Science) had a strong bullpen appearance, shutting out the Golden Bears in four innings, with just four hits allowed.

The Golden Bears were led by three home runs in the game. As Liz Jarosz, Swenson and Schanks all had homers in game two.

The Golden Eagles will take on St. Cloud State University April 8 at 2 and 4 p.m. in St. Cloud, Minn.
